# DEEP WATER SHARKS



## FRILLED SHARK

*Chlamydoselachus anguineus*

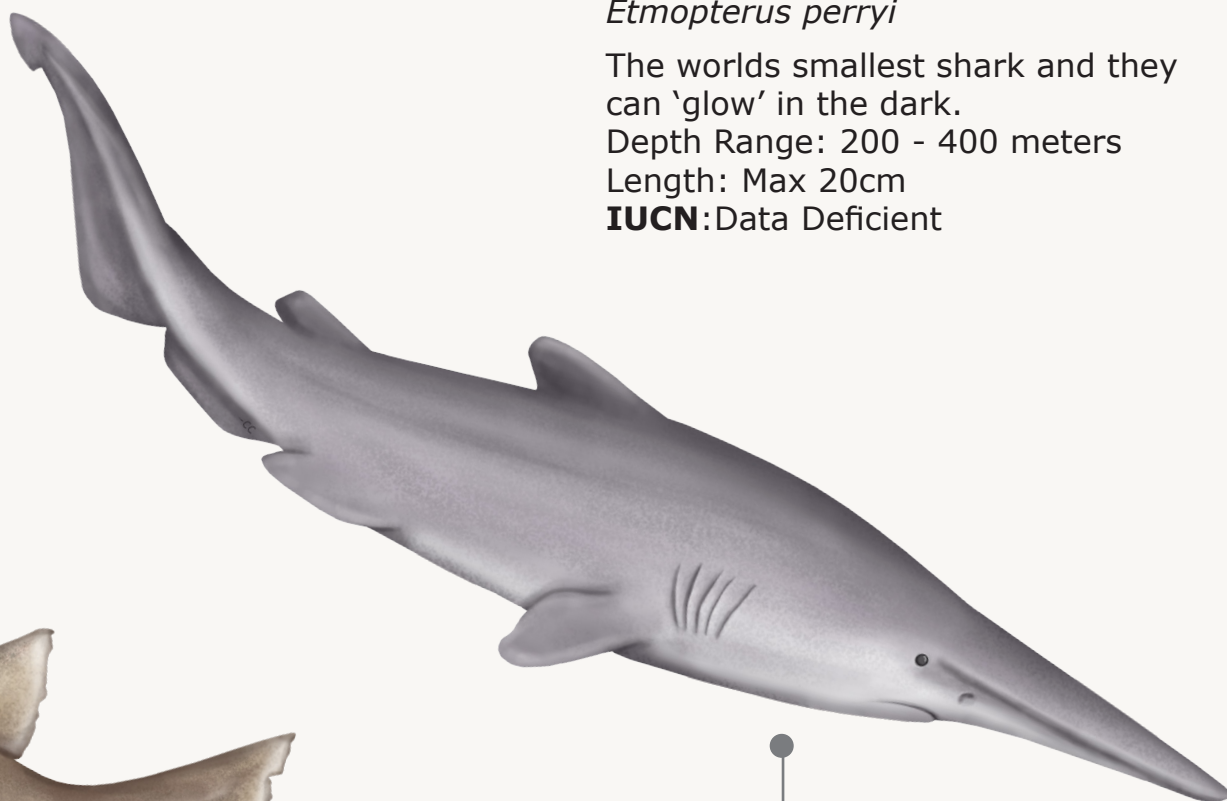
Rare serpent like shark  
Depth Range: 1,200 - 1,500 meters  
Length: 2 meters  
**IUCN:** Near Threatened



## DWARF LANTERN SHARK

*Etmopterus perryi*

The worlds smallest shark and they can 'glow' in the dark.  
Depth Range: 200 - 400 meters  
Length: Max 20cm  
**IUCN:** Data Deficient



## GOBLIN SHARK

*Mitsukurina owstoni*

Also known as "living Fossil" - shark family over 125 million years old  
Depth Range: 300 - 1,400 meters  
Length: 3 - 4 meters  
**IUCN:** Least Concern



## PRICKLY DOGFISH SHARK

*Oxynotus bruniensis*

Extremely rough skin and humped back  
Depth Range: 350 - 1,000 meters  
Length: 75 - 91cm  
**IUCN:** Data Deficient

### IUCN RED LIST CATEGORIES

#### DATA DEFICIENT

More information is needed to assess species conservation status

#### LEAST CONCERN

Species population is not currently a concern or considered for the threatened category

#### NEAR THREATENED

Species population is close to being added to the threatened category

#### VULNERABLE

Species considered to be facing a high risk of extinction in the wild - action required

#### ENDANGERED

Species considered to be facing a very High risk of extinction in the wild - action greatly required

#### CRITICALLY ENDANGERED

Species considered to be facing an extremely high risk of extinction in the wild - severe action required
